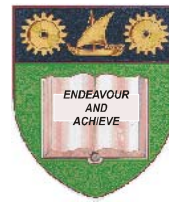

Subject: **Second MPUC Research proposal Call**

The Research Committee of Mombasa Polytechnic University College through the directorate of Research, Innovation, Entrepreneurship and Extension (RIEE) is making a second (2nd) research proposal call to be funded by the institution from its research grant. In this regard, faculty and/or department based research committees (research groups) are requested to submit research proposals that reflect on thematic areas where the concerned faculties or departments have competencies that would enable them make a contribution in bridging information gap or widening frontiers of knowledge. This is a second research proposal call to all MPUC staff / researchers aimed at facilitating the institution's research activities towards the achievement of its vision of becoming a centre of excellence in technology based training and research hub both regionally and globally. The grant application ceiling levels are as summarized below:

<u>Target applicants</u>	<u>Funding Level (Kshs.)</u>
1. Faculty based proposals	1.5 million
2. Department based proposals	0.5 million
3. Section based proposals	0.25 million
4. Inter-faculty / departmental based proposals	1.5 million

The research proposal submission deadline will be on 29th January, 2010 at 5pm. The applicants are requested to download model application forms from MPUC's website: <http://www.mombasapoly.ac.ke/download.php>. Electronic copies of these proposals should be sent to the following address: director.riee@mombasapoly.ac.ke and hard copies of the same should be submitted to the directorate of RIEE by the said date. Successful applicants will be awarded funds to commence research work by February 2010. Each proposal should be accompanied by curriculum vitae of the participating scientists, photocopies of national ID cards and a letter from either the Dean / chairperson / director recommending the proposed research work. The letter should clearly indicate how the proposed research would contribute towards the achievement of the departmental / faculty / directorate's research mandate.
